## **Piedmont Board of Trustees**

April 6, 2021 Unapproved Regular Meeting Minutes

- 1) The Meeting of the Piedmont Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. In Attendance: Phil Anderson, Phil Aitken, Jack Parks, Mike Lee & Kim Plymate.
- **2)** Minutes: a) Plymate made **Motion** to approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting on March 16, 2021, **Seconded** by Parks. All voted "Aye". **Motion carried.**
- 3) Planning & Zoning: a) Aaron Horton had turned in all needed information, except the Septic information. Gunderson will do the work, the perk test and calculations and send it all in to DENR. This will meet all the requirements and the License will be issued. b) Stuart Martin, relator, was present to talk about a piece of the Theissen property and discuss what would be allowed on it. Peregrine, who has the property under contract would like to store his Construction equipment on the property and build a house. There was discussion about the Zoning, what it is and what it could be zoned to allow such a use. At the end of the discussion, it was advised to talk to a few of the neighboring property owners and see what they think about this property being used the way they wish to use it.
- **4)** Library: a) Written report was given. Letter from the Library Board was read by Plymate.
- 5) Park: a) Easter Egg Hunt brought over a hundred people to the Park. Clean up was done before hand and again after. Maintenance is being done on Playground equipment, and wood chips need to be brought in again. Discussed parking issues because of pickups and trailers parking in town instead at the trail head. Evans was asked to order signs to be put up around the Park to help with this situation. b) Discussed the Greenscape quote but we are not going to act on it at this time.
