3) Minutes: a) Anderson made Motion, Seconded by Toothman to approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting on July 2, 2019. All voted "Aye". Motion carried.
4) Planning \& Zoning: a)Report: Hirchert/Witham Property after lots of discussion with the County and the State, it was decided that as long as they convey the lots and 1 unit and the County accepts that, they can move on to the Building Permit. Blosmo- changed permit to a thickened edge slab on grade. With the restriction that no one will live in it and he writes a letter to hold the City harmless, the City can do a variance and approve the permit. American Legion-permit approved.
