

**RESOLUTION –2020 - 04**

**RESOLUTION TO CHANGE CITY WATER RATES**

**WHEREAS**, Black Hawk Water District, the City’s bulk water supplier has again raised it rates; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Piedmont recognizes the City Water System promotes the health, safety, and clean water for the residents of the Municipality; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Piedmont’s current rates must be increased to cover the increased rate paid by the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Piedmont Ordinance 2010-2 as Amended by Ordinance 2013-02, Section 20.4.8 allows the City to adjust fees, costs, and expenses established in the Ordinance governing the Water System, provided it does so by resolution and gives proper notice by publication; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Piedmont by Resolution 2016-03 increased the water rates to the current level;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the rates contained in Section 20.4.2 and previously amended by resolution shall be reset as follows:


The residential users’ minimum monthly rate is increased from \$30 per connection to \$33 per connection. For any amount of usage exceeding 3000 gallons, an additional charge of \$4.50 per 1,000 or any part thereof until reaching 10,000 gallons usage in a month will be charged. For usage over 10,000 gallons a month, \$6.50 per 1,000 or any part thereof will be charged. At 20,001 gallons, a charge of \$10.75 per 1,000 or any part thereof will be charged. At 40,001 gallons, a charge of \$13.75 per 1,000 or any part thereof will be charged. These rates shall apply to residential users within the City limits or within Trail West Subdivision.

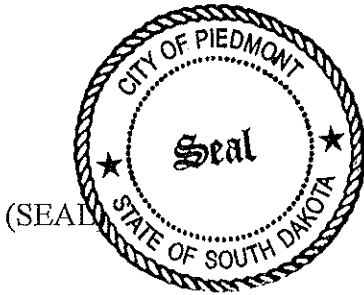
Under Subpart 2, for residences outside of the City, except those in Trail West Subdivision, the monthly minimum is increased from \$45 per month per connection to \$49.50, and any excess usage are charged at the same rate charged for residential users within the City limits.

As to Subpart 3, commercial and industrial users within the municipal boundaries, the monthly minimum fee is increased from \$75 per month per connection to \$78.00. The excess rates are the same as set forth for residential users as contained in this Resolution.

As to Subpart 4, commercial and industrial customers outside the municipal boundaries, the minimum monthly fee is increased from \$90 per month per connection to \$108.00. The excess charges are the same as the excess charges charged for residential users as contained in this Resolution.
