Water Restrictions

Piedmont Residents: If you use your own well to water your yard, this Notice does not pertain to you.

If you use City Water to water your yard, Please read below!

Black Hawk water Users District board of directors has issued water restrictions for the 2017 season. These restrictions go into effect on June 1st and remain in effect until September 30, 2017. Watering days are even, odd. If your address ends in an odd number you may water on odd numbered days of the month. No watering is allowed on the 31st day of any month. Watering may only be done between 6 p.m. and 9 a.m. Hand watering of plants and trees can be done on any day. It is recommended that you avoid watering between the hours of 4 p.m. and 8 p.m. as people are arriving home from work, showering, doing laundry and dishes during this time and water supply is heavily taxed and water outages or shortages could occur. For new grass, sod installation, please call and obtain a verbal waiver from the District Office. 787-5777

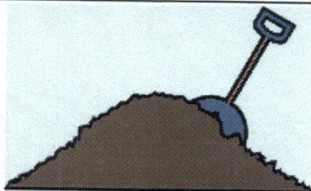

The City of Piedmont allows Open Burning within the Municipality provided a permit is obtained. To obtain a permit contact the South Dakota Division of Wildland Fire Suppression for a Class A permit (wood materials only).
